So you have managed a par at the 2nd!?! Now at third Tee, the second of our 'Amen Corner', and some important decisions, as you face one of the best holes in country golf. This hole challenges golfers of all abilities. This is a 'Mount Pleasant G.C.' signature hole. Go safe up the fairway and leave yourself with at least 160 to the green, take on the corner of the lake (a clearance of about 150m for men and 120m for women) and leave yourself with less than 150m; or do you go for it with up to a 200m clearance? Better be spot on with your length though - short and wet or long and running into a dense tree line...then to attack the course's largest green. But the entrance is protected left and right by classic 200 year old gums narrowing the gateway... do you go under or over, if not in the centre of the fairway?.... a par here is another blessing.... again any uncontrolled hook or slice and it spells **DISASTER.**
