

# **HOLE 4**



Two of three 'Amen Corner' completed and hopefully still in the game. Now the challenge of one of our new holes. This is not a long hole but a direct drive over the hole will have to survive the landing through a shroud of aged gum trees and water to the right of the hole (Yellow Penalty area). A lost ball is a likely outcome for those seeking to eagle or birdie this hole. Risk and Reward. The green is the smallest on the course and the surrounds are very undeveloped, so it is important to hit the green with a lofted shot. So laying up is the best option...but again, length on the first shot is critical so mid irons maybe the best shot or a well shaped 5 wood to accommodate the dog-leg.
