

# HOLE 13



**Great you managed to avoid the water on 12; now you just have to do it again on our new Hole 13. Now a par 5 and not a great distance, but designed to confront the risk and reward challenge. By maximising the length of your drive it will give you an opportunity to play your second to the green and aim to get that birdie. However you will be playing over the rise, blind to the green and only the flag to indicate the line. Adding to the risk is the narrowing perspective of the fairway, with out of bounds on the left becoming a greater consideration, and the water hazard to the right of the green ready to wash your ball. At the moment the fairway is a little scratchy so won't get honest reward if you hit it early. And to add to your concerns, the back apron of the green falls away markedly. The other option is to lay up at the 100m and play a lofted shot safely to the green you can now see. No real trick on this green so a par is a fair result.**
